The Playcentre has its own personalized track suit tops and summer T-shirts. They are in the colours of the groups.

We encourage all children to wear these tops for three reasons:

Firstly it gives them the security and pride in belonging to their group and school. Secondly, Mum does not have to worry much about good clothes being ruined. Thirdly, it makes our children very easy to spot on outings and in a crowd.

The T-shirts do not necessarily have to be worn every day, only during outings and special days, e.g. sports day and photograph day.

All other clothing worn must be old and comfortable, easy to remove and put back on. Children cannot enjoy themselves to the full if they have to stay clean and neat. Neither can they learn independent toilet habits if they cannot dress or undress themselves.

Bare feet are happy feet. Children cannot climb, run or exercise the muscles in their feet properly if they have to wear shoes all the time. If the weather is warm, leave the shoes at home.
